Unleashing the potential of data – for EU businesses and citizens

Context: Language Technologies, Artificial Intelligence (Intleacht Shaorga) and (Large) Language Models

- Language Technologies (LT) and Artificial Intelligence (AI) need language data
- Large Language Models (LLMs) lead now the AI race, needing vast amounts of language data to train them
- Europe's languages are largly under-resourced, except English
- Concerted effort needed to collect enormous amounts of language data for all European languages



LDS and the Digital Europe Programme

The Common European Language Data Space (LDS)

- Builds upon previous initiatives focusing on making language data available
- Data Spaces are an inherent part of the EU Data Strategy
- One of the approx. 20 official EU data space projects: strong focus on industry
- Looks to establish the European data market:
 - supporting Technology players and Language Data providers
 - focusing on data sharing and monetising
