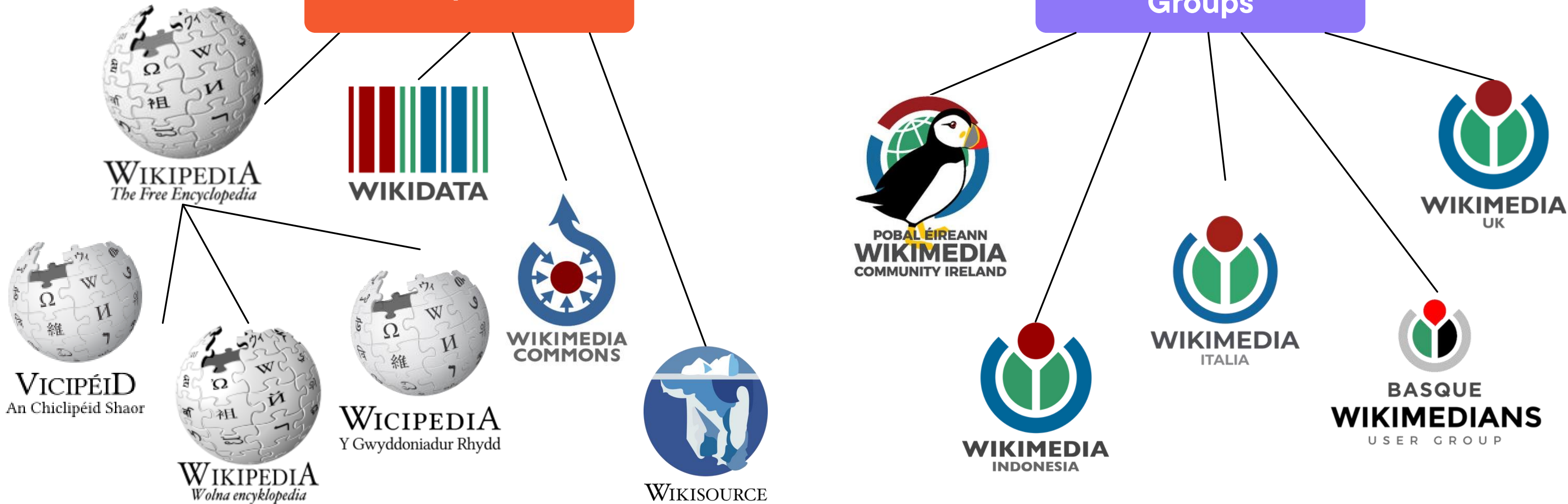

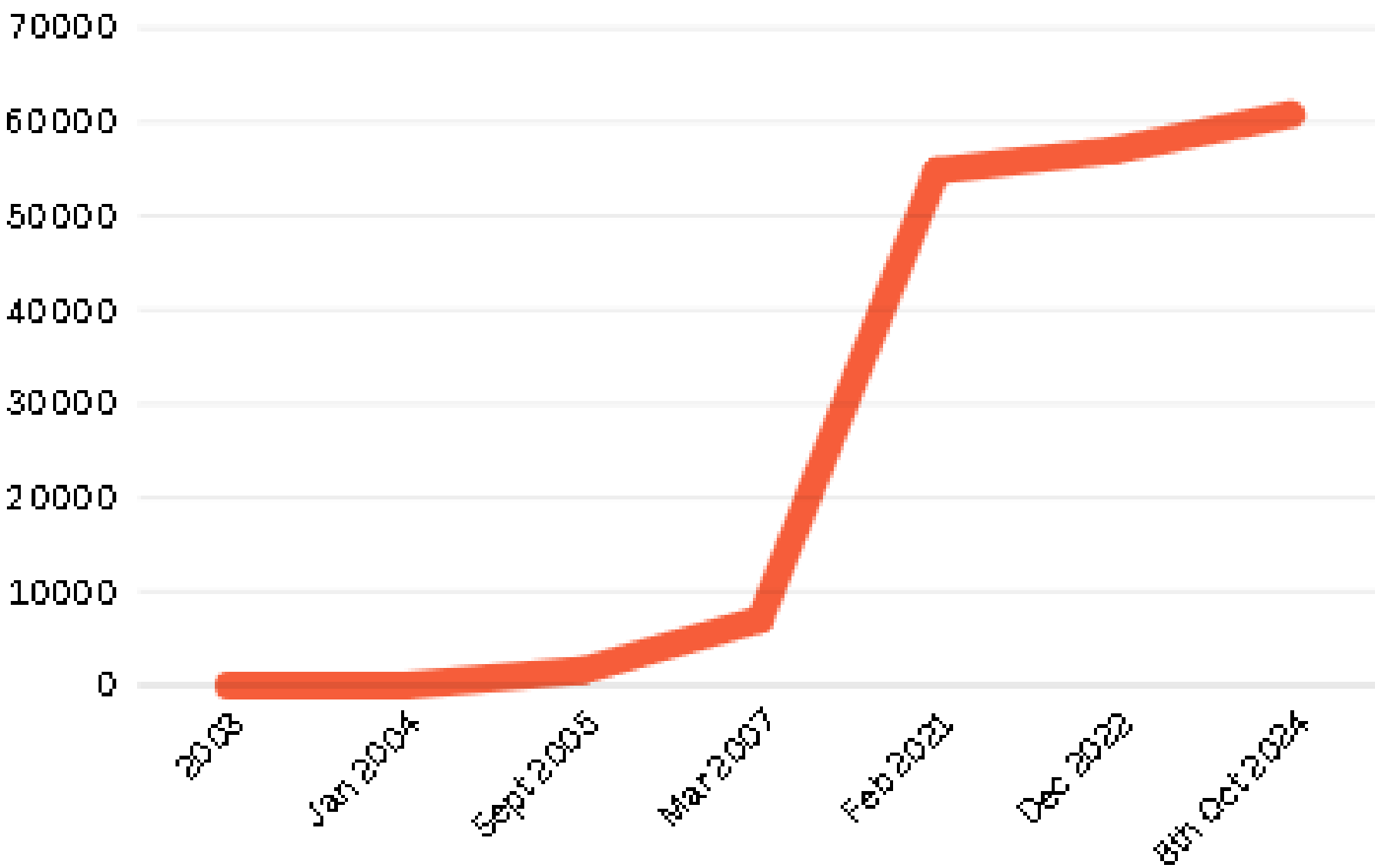

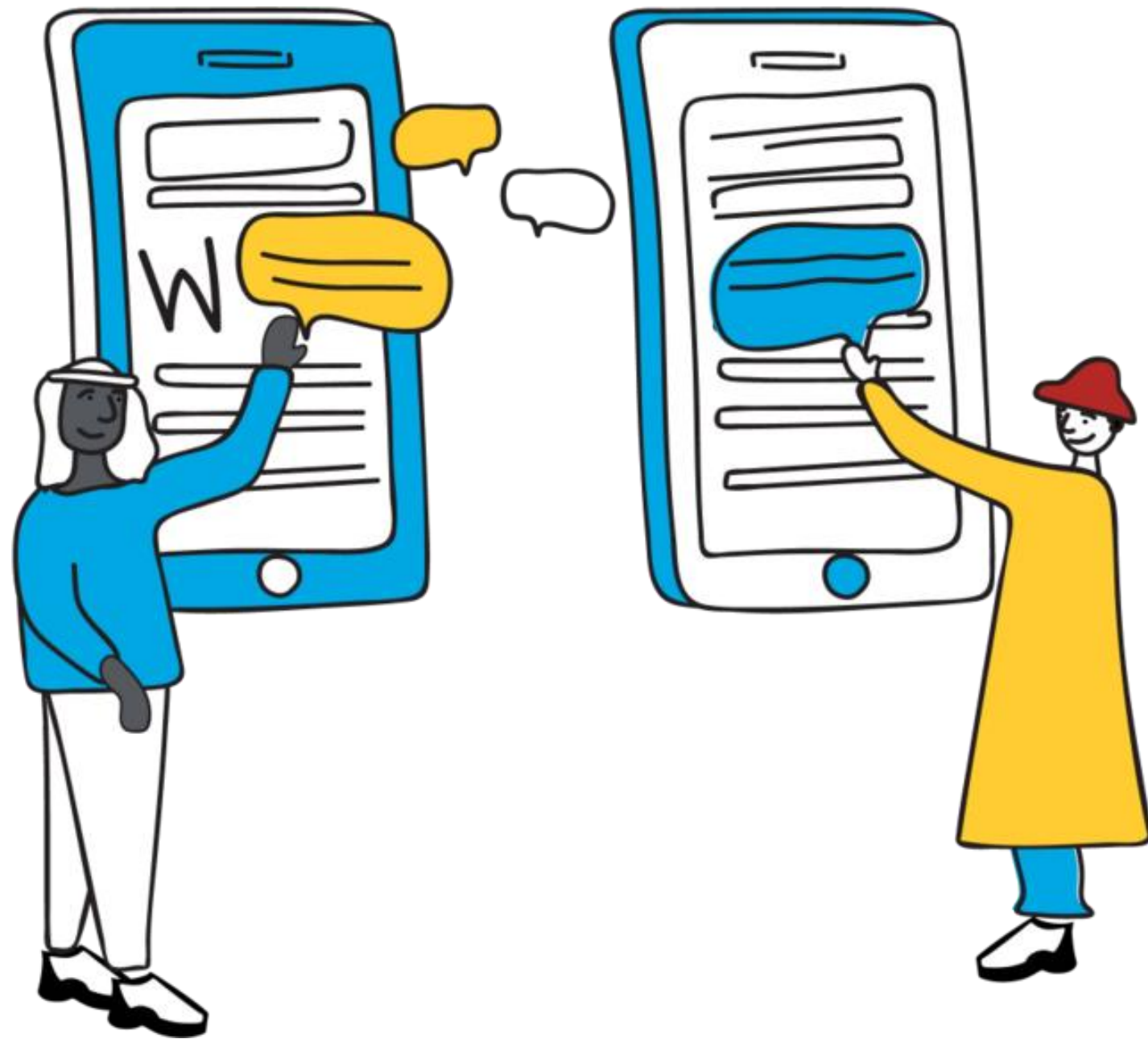


Digital Plan for Irish Language 2023–2027

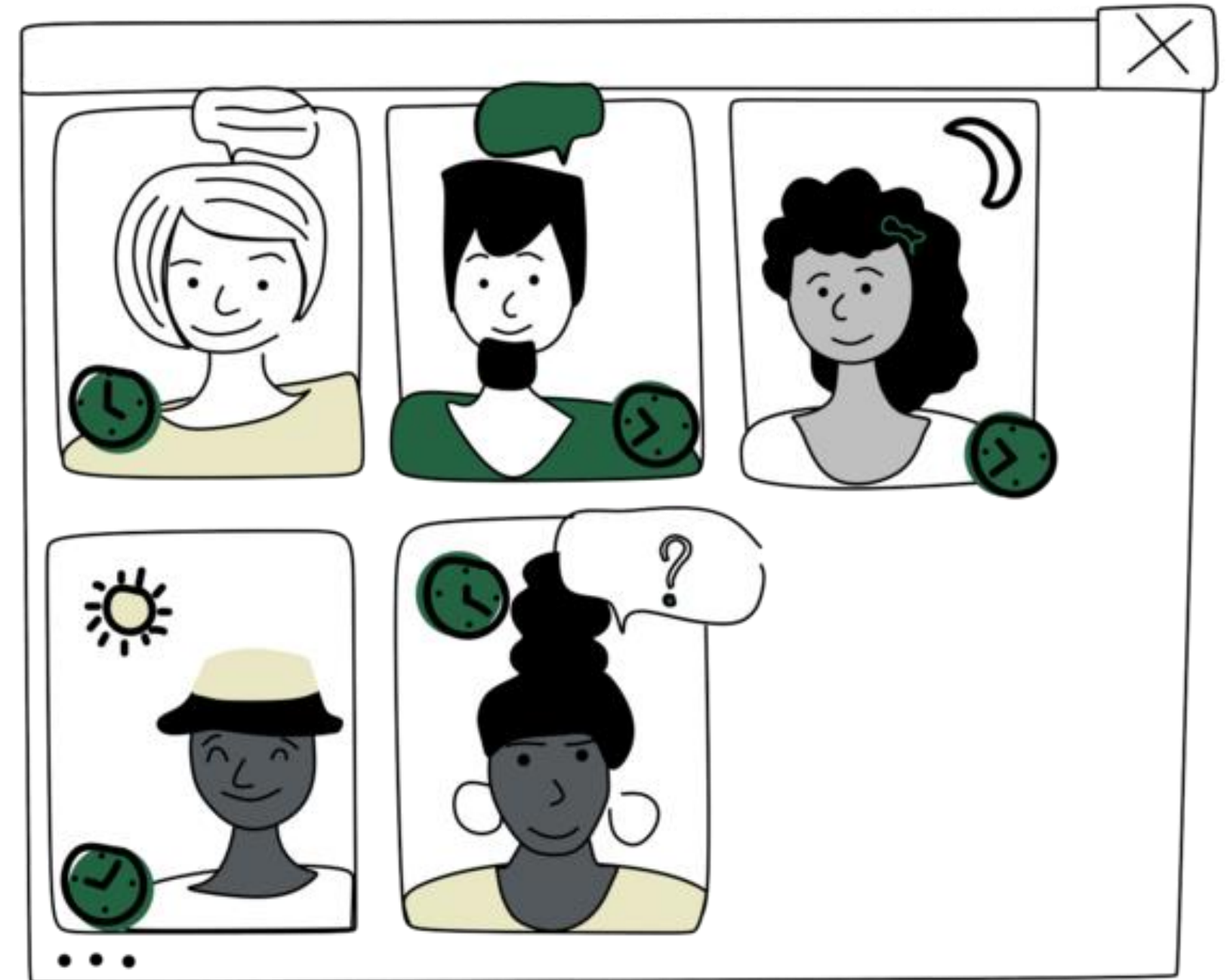

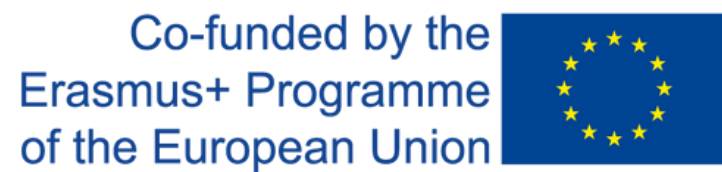
