Program for "Large Research Infrastructures"

- Large Research Infrastructure: According to Paragraph 2, Article 2, Letter (d) of the Act No 130/2002 Coll., on support of research, experimental development and innovation from public funds and amending certain related acts (Act on Support of Research, Experimental Development and Innovation), a large research infrastructure is legally defined as a "research infrastructure, which is a research facility necessary for comprehensive research and development with high financial and technological intensity, which is approved by the government and established for use by other research organisations."
- a unique facility with both national impact and international overlap. A large research infrastructure is thus "large" due to its unique expertise

LINDAT/CLARIAH-CZ

- **a) project funding** (*projects LM*...; LM2023062) for LRI -> services provided by LINDAT/CLARIAH-CZ;
- funding period now till 2026, the next funding period starting from 2027 (-> expected to be for 8 years)
 - -> sustainability

- LINDAT/CLARIAH-CZ
- a) project funding (projects LM...)

- Administered by MEYS (Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports)
- Procedure for being approved for funding 1. International Assessment,
 2. political decision (by the Governmente of the Czech Republic)
- 4/8 years period

LINDAT/CLARIAH-CZ

- National consortium of 17 research institutions, providing services and tools for language research, but also for digital humanities
- Organised by Charles University (Faculty of Mathematics and Fyzics)

LINDAT/CLARIAH-CZ

b) "institutional" funding

- Membership fees into ERICs and EDIC
- **ERIC** = European Research Infrastructure Consortium;
 - administered by MEYS
- **EDIC** = European Digital Infrastructure Consortium;
 - administrator depends on the particular EDIC

LINDAT/CLARIAH-CZ

b) "institutional" funding

- Membership fees into ERICs and EDIC:
- CLARIN ERIC Common Language Resources and Technology Infrastructure
- DARIAH ERIC Digital Research Infrastructure for the Arts and Humanities
- EHRI (ERIC) European Holocaust Research Infrastructure
- ALT-EDIC Alliance for Language Technologies

b) "institutional" funding

- duration of the funding - accordingly to the ERICs and EDICs statutes (in case Czechia would decide to withdraw from the consortia; however, there is currently no intention to withdraw ③)

c) funding for investments of LRIs

- Johannes Amos Comenius Programme
- Programme cofinanced by EU
