The "Generative AI and Data Spaces" white paper of the DSSC's Strategic Stakeholder Forum (SSF) explores the intersection of generative artificial intelligence (AI) and data spaces. It focuses on how combining these two fields can support innovative data-sharing ecosystems while adhering to principles, such as data sovereignty, trust, and interoperability. The white paper outlines key recommendations to enable more effective integration of generative AI into data spaces, fostering collaboration, transparency, and sustainable data management strategies within the European framework. 


Support
